The 13 Articles

1. God alone is Creator.
2. He is absolutely One.
3. He has no body or bodily shape.
4. He is the first and the last.
5. Only to Him may we pray and to no other.
6. The words of the prophets are true.
7. The prophecy of Moses is true, and he is the father of all prophets.
8. The Torah was given by Moses.
9. This Torah is not subject to change, and there will never be another Torah from the Creator.
10. The Creator knows all the thoughts and deeds of man.
11. He rewards and punishes according to the deed.
12. The Messiah will come; though He tarry, I will expect Him daily.
13. The dead will be resurrected.
